Campaign Ends with Success

—Building the Future Campaign Raises \$2,175,903



MTSA's *Building the Future Campaign* was very successful as 532 donors supported the effort while giving more than \$2.1 million to fund construction, renovation, and equipment for the School's facility needs.

The MTSA *Building the Future Campaign*—the School's first-ever major fundraising effort has come to a very successful close says Jim Closser, MTSA Vice President for Advancement & Alumni. More than \$2,175,000 was contributed by foundations, corporations, community friends, and members of the MTSA family including its board of trustees, alumni, faculty, administration, staff, and students.

These funds have been used to improve the MTSA campus by adding a new simulation skills center and associated equipment, classroom lecture hall, student lounge, computer lab, and total renovation of the library, seminar rooms, conference room, and support offices.

Additionally, both Buildings A & B were purchased from the former Tennessee Christian Medical Center as part of the effort.

“Without the support of our funding partners, we would not be able to provide such wonderful facilities to our students,” said MTSA President Ken Schwab. “We indeed are grateful for our contributing friends who chose to join us in a mission to provide excellence in Christian anesthesia education.”

- **MTSA recently received notice** from Martha L. Barr, MSN, RN, Associate Executive Director of the Tennessee Board of Nursing regarding student loan repayment and professional licensure. As can be seen below, she recommends that this information be provided to students. Additionally, as a service to alumni, MTSA is publishing this information, so that alumni who may still be in the student loan repayment process are also informed.

"The Board [of Nursing] is required by law to indefinitely suspend the license of a nurse upon determination that the licensee is in default on a student loan and has not made arrangements with the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation (TSAC) for repayment. The Board [of Nursing] asked that you be provided with this information to use as you see fit such as to inform your students of the consequences for nonpayment."

- **The MTSA CEC Cruise Symposium** to the Western Caribbean has been cancelled based on low registration and response. All deposit and registration fees have been refunded for those pre-registered. We regret any inconvenience this may have caused.

- **The new class of 2013** will begin MTSA orientation on May 16, 2011.

two gifts of \$500,000 or more, two gifts of \$100,000 or more and one gift of \$50,000. The average gift for the entire campaign was \$4,090.

"We also are very grateful for the broad MTSA alumni participation we had in the campaign," said Closser. "We had 217 MTSA alumni support the campaign which is a 17.5 percent alumni participation rate, with an average gift of \$1,081. MTSA alumni from all across the country were most generous, supportive, and involved in this program."

The *Bernard V. Bowen Society* has been an important part of the program. Many *Bowen Society* members have made, and continue to make, regular annual contributions (\$1,000) to maintain active membership or a one-time lifetime membership (\$10,000). During the course of the campaign we had 17 Lifetime members, 70 annual members, and 11 student members (\$100).

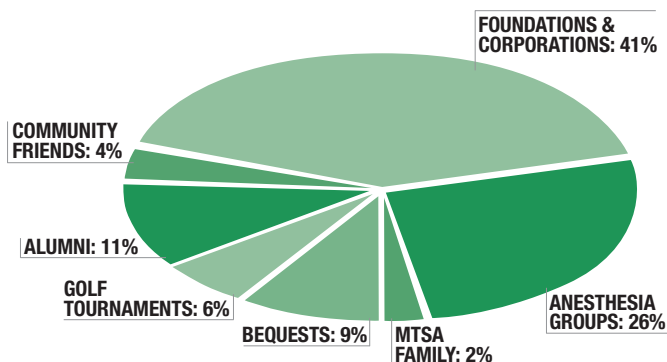
You may be interested to know that we currently have only \$5,824.75 in outstanding pledge receivables still on the books. Therefore, of the nearly \$2.2 million raised, less than \$6,000 is still owed as outstanding or payable pledges – and our contributing partners are continuing to satisfy these pledges. Closser said, "This is a tremendous testament to our friends and supporters that made commitments to the campaign and then continued to remain faithful to complete pledges."

"We are so thankful for each and every dollar associated with this campaign," said Schwab. "As important as the money is in a campaign like this, I appreciate the spirit and commitment of the donors choosing to invest in our future and mission."
