Building for the Future

Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia has a long and rich tradition of academic excellence in educating nurses to reflect Christ in their anesthesia practice. The initial class of two students entering the program in 1950 has developed into a class of 70 who began their Broadfield's orientation on Monday, July 25. More than 1000 MTSA graduates are serving their respective communities across the country and in several foreign countries.

Over the past three years plans have developed and been approved by the Board of Trustees to purchase, enlarge, and renovate current facilities. The purchase of 2.51 acres of land and two buildings will be accomplished within the next few weeks. Renovation of the dormitory building has already begun. Projections have the library, Learning Resource Center/computer laboratory, and two offices moving to their newly renovated areas within the next two months. Once the library has moved from their current location, renovation will begin immediately to develop and equip a skills laboratory/surgery suite, control room, mannequin storage, and a debriefing/conference room where students can practice intubation, administration of anesthetics, assess the condition of SimMan, and then discuss various scenarios in the adjacent debriefing room.

It is projected that the new addition of a 106 seat amphitheater classroom, new handicapped accessible bathrooms, and student lounge will be ready for occupancy by January 1, 2006. Students seated in this classroom will be able to observe and hear what is happening in the skills laboratory, thus learn from and critique the scenario/case study situations. All classes and presentations in the new classroom will be digitally recorded, edited, and then made available for online learning or review by current students.

MTSA is currently collaborating with Vanderbilt University to offer, via BlackBoard, course syllabi, PowerPoint presentations, handouts, and other course materials. In addition, quizzes and testing will eventually be offered via BlackBoard in the new computer laboratory.

The current and projected changes within the next six months will significantly impact the teaching/learning environment for our students. In addition, the added space will allow MTSA to provide much-needed office space for additional faculty and staff. We believe these changes will strengthen our existing facilities and programs and I encourage MTSA alumni and friends to come and see what is happening. You, our alumni, are important to MTSA and we encourage your feedback and support of our current and future projects/programs.
