Edmondson Appointed Advancement Committee Chairman – Leads \$3.0 Million Campaign

Jack Edmondson, CRNA has been appointed advancement committee chairman of the Middle Tennessee School (MTSA) of Anesthesia ***“Building the Future Campaign.”***

Edmondson is a 1979 CRNA graduate of MTSA returning in 1996 to continue his education and earn a masters degree in anesthesia. He currently practices anesthesia at Sumner Memorial Health System in Gallatin, Tennessee. Mr. Edmondson earned a bachelors degree in business administration from Atlantic Union College and an associate degree in nursing from Quinsigamond University. He is a past MTSA alumni president, currently president-elect of the alumni association, and member of the MTSA board of trustees.

Since enrollment at MTSA has more than doubled in the last four years, a major expansion is currently underway which will more than double the classroom and lab areas of the school, explains Edmondson. The MTSA Board of Trustees initiated the \$3.0 million ***“Building the Future Campaign”*** to help fund this major building project.

“We are very excited about the current direction of the master plan and building program,” says Edmondson. “The administration and board considered many options for the school’s physical plant, including but not limited to relocation. The project of which we are pursuing currently allows us to meet all the growth needs of the school while being fiscal stewards of the financial resources entrusted to our care.”

“Reflecting Christ in Anesthesia Education” is the mission of MTSA. Many students choose MTSA over other accredited anesthesia programs in that it’s a single-purpose school dealing solely with anesthesia. MTSA is one of 98 schools of anesthesia in the country with students that do exceptionally well on the certification exam with a 99.9 percent pass rate and scores well above the national average.”

MTSA Application Process Update

Upon reading this heading, many may wonder, “Why on earth is the application process at MTSA relevant to me, an alumnus?” The reason is that you, the alumni of MTSA, are the best recruitment tool for this school. You interact on daily with the RNs in the critical care units who may be interested in pursuing a career in nurse anesthesia. You are the ones these RNs observe, target as role models, and question about the profession. Many of them conclude, “I want to be a quality anesthetist just like him, so I want to go to school where he did.” Therefore, you are who they will ask for preliminary information about schools of anesthesia. Some of you may be asked to provide references for them when they do apply to MTSA.

Since you are an integral part of the public image and reputation of MTSA to others, it is important you be made aware of changes that will impact the information you share with RNs interested in applying. As ambassadors for MTSA, you need to be provided with new information about changes in application deadlines.

For many years, MTSA has conducted the regular student applicant interview sessions in mid-January, prior to the enrollment date later that year, at the end of July. However, the Admissions Committee has determined this scheduling may present difficulties for some applicants who are not selected for admission that year, but are advised to complete additional courses, such as Advanced Pathophysiology and Advanced Pharmacology, prior to re-applying and interviewing again the following year. When these applicants did not receive word of this recommendation until late January, it was then too late to apply to take a course during the winter-spring semester. To alleviate this scheduling conflict, MTSA has changed the dates for the regular student applicant interviews from mid-January to early December. Therefore, the regular interview sessions will be held on **Tuesday, December 5** and **Wednesday, December 6, 2006**, to interview for a position in the Class of 2007-2009. The early interview date has not been set, but will precede the regular interview session. Most likely, the early interviews will occur at some time in early November, prior to the Thanksgiving holiday period.

Since the interviews will be held more than a month earlier than in the past, the deadline for having a completed application file has also been altered. To be considered by the Screening Committee for an Early Interview, an applicant must first meet all the criteria as discussed in the *2006 Catalog and Recruitment Manual, p. 9* (available at www.mtsa.edu). The applicant must then ensure his completed file is in the office of the Admissions Coordinator no later than September 15, 2006, to be considered for an invitation for an Early Interview. In order to be considered by the Screening Committee to be invited to have a Regular Interview with the Admissions Committee, the applicant's completed file must be in the Admission Coordinator's office no later than September 30, 2006. A completed file consists of a recently-revised 2006 application form, the \$50 application fee, a personal letter from the applicant, official copies of all transcripts from all schools attended since graduation from high school, and five reference forms from individuals as discussed in the *Catalog*.

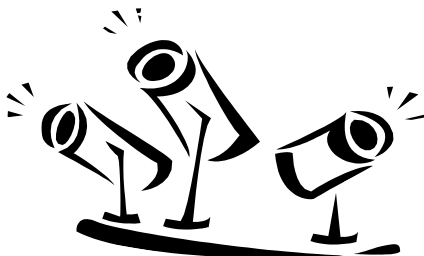

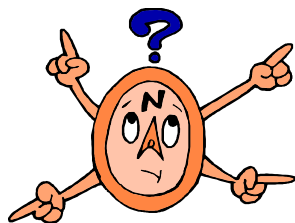

Fast Food

*Quick and Easy
for Busy People*

- 1 Tbsp. margarine
- 8 oz. mushrooms, finely chopped
- 1/2 cup plain dry bread crumbs
- 1 cup cholesterol-free egg product
- 5 frozen BOCA Meatless Breakfast Links, chopped
- 1/2 of a medium red bell pepper, chopped
- 3 green onions, sliced
- 1/8 tsp. ground red pepper (cayenne)

Preheat oven to 350. Spray 9-inch pie plate with cooking spray; set aside. Melt margarine in large nonstick skillet on medium-high heat. Add mushrooms; cook and stir 8 min. or until liquid has evaporated. Remove from heat. Stir in bread crumbs. Place in prepared pie plate; pres firmly onto bottom of pie plate to form crust. **Mix** egg product, link pieces, bell pepper, onions and ground red pepper; pour over crust. **Bake** 20 min. or until center is set.

(You can substitute 4 eggs, lightly beaten for the egg product)

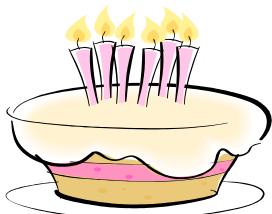

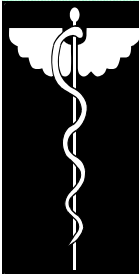
