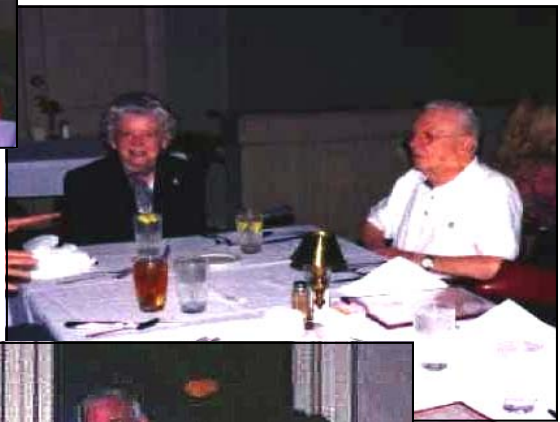

## Spotlight on Alumni...



### ***The Story of Clyde Ball*** (as told to Jane Pennington)

Clyde Ball graduated from Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia (then known as Madison Hospital School of Anesthesia) in September 1967. Some of his fellow classmates were Glen Belk, Lois Bernard, and Doris Byrd.

He first worked at St. Thomas Hospital for a year and a half, while doing part-time work in OB on weekends at Baptist Hospital. From there he went into freelance work with Smyrna and Donelson Hospitals along with work in other smaller hospitals in the Nashville area.

Clyde moved to Bowling Green, KY in October of 1968 and worked there until 1981. Following this time, he started doing *locum tenums* in Bedford, IN for a short period of time. Then he traveled to Baltimore to work in the Shock Trauma Unit which had been started by Dr. Adam Crowley after Dr. Crowley returned from his tour of duty in Vietnam. Clyde indicates that this was the first such trauma unit in the United States.

At this point Clyde decided to do a bit of traveling and worked up and down the East coast from Clear Water to Baltimore performing *locum tenums* in a number of different hospitals along the way.

Clyde retired from Anesthesia practice in October, 1994 after developing heart complications, and undergoing bypass surgery. He reports that he is doing well now, and is thoroughly enjoying retirement

Clyde married Trannie Woodson in September of 2005. They met in 1957 on the porch of Madison Academy, and had been friends for many years. They live in West Tennessee now in Greenfield.

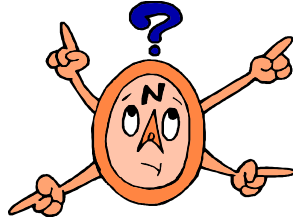

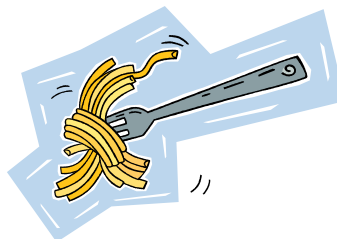

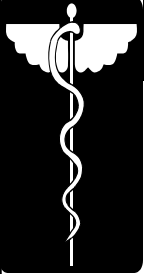
