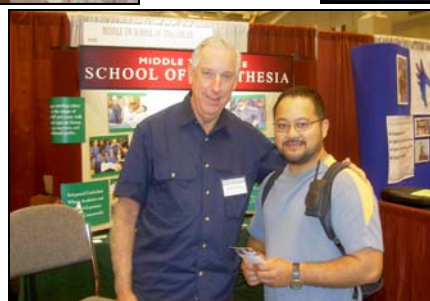
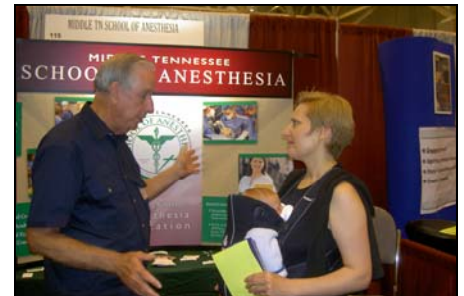

June 30th thru July 9th was the 58th World-wide General Conference of Seventh-Day Adventists Business Session that convenes every 5 years. This is when S.D.A.'s come together from literally all over the world and take care of business issues along with worshipping and sharing their cultures and ministries with a huge group of people! The business meetings cover an array of tasks, including voting on several matters involving the organization of the Adventist world church and choosing who will lead the church in the coming five years. The daily average attendance was about 10,000 people and on the two weekends about 70,000 people attended. Quite often it is held overseas, but this time it was just a hop, skip and a jump away in St. Louis, MO. By sponsoring a booth this year, MTSA was able to enlighten the Seventh-Day Adventist membership regarding the opportunities of the only S.D.A.-connected CRNA program and to meet personally with nursing students and their family members who are interested in continuing their post-baccalaureate education. Dr. Hunt, Ikey & Bernard DeVasher and our recruitment specialist Debbie Rose were all able to communicate with S.D.A. colleges and universities and their staff/faculty who exhibit at this event. They also connected with MTSA alumni and fostered constituent support for the school, which is always a good thing.

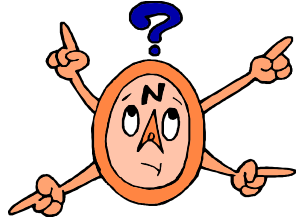

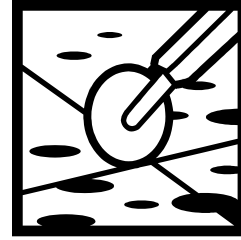

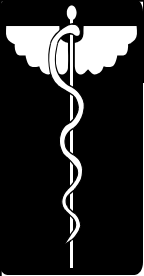
